Matters arising

- 1. <u>Car parking in Llan village</u> S Reast has met Tony Evans on site and is awaiting a quotation no update
- <u>Request for cycle path around the Community Field</u> The tree cutting has been completed. More tenders for grass cutting and line painting are pending. R Ashton has ordered beech trees and S Reast has organised a hedge planting day. S Reast to write to David Thompson (Powys) to ask for Right of Access and copying G Mitchell in
- 3. <u>Public toilets</u> A quotation from Adam Toye was presented for the work needed. Adam has given a timeframe for the various parts of the project and it was agreed that he should be asked to do the ceiling in the men's toilets as soon as possible. S Reast, Mark Shelley, Adam Toye and I Edwards to meet on site to discuss the next steps including insulating the pipes. In the meantime, the disabled toilet has remained open for the public to use
- 4. <u>Noticeboards</u> The new noticeboard for Bont is arriving on the 22nd of February. F Cauley to co-ordinate it's installation
- 5. <u>Defibrillator equipment in the Llanbrynmair area</u> the Councillors were asked if they would take responsibility for checking the defibs in their area. I Edwards gave a demonstration of the features to pay attention to at the end of the meeting using the Community Centre Defib
- <u>Consider new equipment for the Playground</u> The Lottery application has been successful and £20,000.00 will be paid to the Council for new equipment. S Reast to co-ordinate the work with Wicksteed. A quote from AlTechnical for CCTV was presented but considered too expensive for the time being
- Hedges by Pont Bel S Reast has heard from the owners of Ty'n Ddol and is making enquiries about possible contractors to do the work. G Davies offered his services and S Reast will send contact details on
- 8. <u>Concealed entrance, Maes yr Efail</u> B Jones and R Ashton to install metal post for mirror no update

- Station House, Talerddig There will be a meeting on the 21st of February. S Evans, P Jones and F Cauley would like to attend and maybe E Lewis and E Davies. Questions will have to be sent ahead to Children's Services
- 10. <u>Bins at the bottom of Bryneinty Road</u> S Reast has written to Powys again and received a response saying that the matter is under consideration no update, S Reast to chase
- 11. <u>Lloches bws Dolfach</u> A meeting was held on site with the contractors and E Lewis on the 17th of January. S Reast has asked Openreach to move the pole in the middle of the pavement which is causing an obstruction to the ideal location of the shelter. They would charge £1200.00 to do a survey and around £10,000.00 to move the pole
- 12. <u>Trimming hedge and undergrowth in Bont</u> Work underway by Josh Reast No update
- 13. <u>Bench in Dolfach</u> S Reast to write to Powys again for permission to locate one in Dolfach. Tony Evans has offered an estimate of £250 £300 to do the work no update
- 14. <u>Broken shed in the play park</u> Waiting for dry weather to move the shed no update
- 15. <u>Response to the Rally</u> Everyone was happy with the letter sent to residents by the secretary of the rally
- 16. <u>Footpath from Dolfach to Llanbrynmair and to the Tafolwern turning</u> It was agreed that this should be dscussed when Russell George AS visits
- 17. <u>Rubbish in the park</u> S Reast has not had a response from Probation Services. In the meantime Josh Reast had to go in to cut up and clear a fallen tree and collected the litter while he was about it
- 18. <u>Speed signs by Dolgadfan crossroads</u> The incorrect speed signs have been removed
- 19. <u>Fence around Pump House in Bont</u> S Reast has written to Dwr Cymru and received confirmation that it is on their work schedule
- 20. <u>Data projector</u> S Reast asked if the Council would like to make use of the data projector belonging to the school/community centre in order to save on printing and paper. It was agreed that it should be tried
- 21. <u>Kieron-Owen trailer on Brynaire road</u> S Reast has written to Kieron-Owen and received an apology in return
- 22. <u>Bt Exchange roof</u> A panel had come loose in high winds. The problem was reported to Openreach and they came to fix it
