The Chairman, E Davies, extended a warm welcome to all

Presentations – Cllr. Elwyn Vaughan to discuss a project to promote the Welsh language through various activities over 2 years including translation services for the Council

Approving minutes of previous meeting held on 6th December 2023

Everyone in agreement

Matters arising

- 1. <u>Car parking in Llan village</u> S Reast has met Tony Evans on site and is awaiting a quotation
- <u>Request for cycle path around the Community Field</u> The tree cutting will start next week. It was agreed that tenders should be invited for the grass cutting and line painting again. R Ashton to order beech trees. S Reast to organise a hedge planting day
- <u>Public toilets</u> No quotations have arrived from any builders yet. It was agreed in principal that a timetable of work should be organised with the most urgent matters done first. S Reast has received a copy of the lease from Powys which confirms that all repairs and renewals are the responsibility of Llanbrynmair Community Council
- 4. <u>Noticeboards</u> The new noticeboard for Bont is expected in the next fortnight. I Edwards has mended the closer on the Talerddig noticeboard
- 5. <u>Defibrillator equipment in the Llanbrynmair area</u> It was agreed that the defibrillator in Bont would be moved when the new noticeboard is installed
- 6. <u>Consider new equipment for the Playground</u> The Lottery application has been submitted and S Reast needs to contact AITechnical again for a quote for CCTV
- 7. <u>Hedges by Pont Bel</u> S Reast to write to the owners of Ty'n Ddol again
- 8. <u>Concealed entrance, Maes yr Efail</u> B Jones and R Ashton to install metal post for mirror
- 9. <u>Station House, Talerddig</u> G Mitchell to make enquiries about another meeting on the site no update
- 10. <u>Bins at the bottom of Bryneinty Road</u> S Reast has written to Powys again and received a response saying that the matter is under consideration
- 11. <u>Lloches bws Dolfach</u> There will be a meeting on site with the contractors on the 17th of January. D Jones, E Lewis, and maybe I Edwards and P Jones to attend
- 12. <u>Trimming hedge and undergrowth in Bont</u> Work underway by Josh Reast No update

- 13. <u>Bench in Dolfach</u> S Reast to write to Powys again for permission to locate one in Dolfach. Tony Evans has offered an estimate of £250 £300 to do the work
- 14. Broken shed in the play park Waiting for dry weather to move the shed
- 15. <u>Response to the Rally</u> A letter from the rally organisers was presented. It was agreed that it should be discussed again at the next meeting when everyone has had a chance to read it
- 16. <u>Footpath from Dolfach to Llanbrynmair and to the Tafolwern turning</u> It was agreed that this should be dscussed when Russell George AS visits
- 17. <u>Rubbish in the park</u> A suggestion was made to ask the probation services to help. There are various sites that could do with attention at the same time
- 18. <u>Speed signs by Dolgadfan crossroads</u> The speed signs are inconsistent. G Mitchell has taken this up with Powys
- 19. <u>Vehicle on white lines by turning from B4518 to the A470</u> Situation needs monitoring
- 20. Fence around Pump House in Bont S Reast to write to Dwr Cymru
- 21. <u>Setting the precept</u> Having studied the budget, it was agreed that the precept be raised from £14,000.00 to £15,000.00

Road matters

- <u>A470 matters</u> S Reast to invite Russel George AS to discuss the following ; 1. The road collapse by Dolgoch and the effect of closing it on the route between Talerddig and Bont whilst work is done. 2. Speed of traffic at the Wynnstay corner. 3. Speed of traffic in Talerddig. 4. Pathway from Dolfach to Llanbrynmair and on to Tafolwern
- <u>Salt bins</u> Preparations needed for bad weather. S Reast asks that any residents with a need for salt and grit top-ups should contact her directly
- <u>Street lighting</u> Trees need trimming around a light opposite Pengeulan and another just above Bryncoch drive is flashing during the daytime. S Reast has reported both to Powys
- E Davies and G Mitchell went on a tour of inspection to discuss the following issues:
 1. White stones and posts beside the Pandy road.
 2. Road collapsing below Lluest.
 3. Drain by Hen Gapel.
 4. Condition of the far end of Pandy/Tafolog road.
 5. Roots beside the road by Penfilltir, Bont and 6. Condition of Cwmcarnedd road. Since then G Mitchell has also met with Aled Jones to go over the same ground. The drain at Hen Gapel will be a priority
