Minutes of meeting held on Wednesday, 5th June 2024.

The Chairman, E Davies, extended a warm welcome to all

Approving minutes of previous meeting held on 6th March 2024

I Edwards proposing, B Jones seconding, everyone in agreement

Matters arising

- 1. <u>Car parking in Llan village</u> S Reast and F Cauley have moved the old noticeboard from the shop wall in Llanbrynmair but not yet to the site in Llan
- 2. <u>Community Field</u> The appropriate signage has been installed and the field is open to the public. The size and orientation of the football pitch was discussed as well as the need for goal posts. S Reast to remind P Jones about clearing the trunks in the corner
- 3. <u>Public toilets</u> S Reast is waiting for the results of the grant application to pay for plumbing renewal in order to re-open the toilets. In the meantime, the difficulties with the temporary arrangements were discussed. S Reast has asked David Williams to empty, clean and replenish water twice a week as opposed to once as it is getting so busy
- 4. <u>Defibrillator equipment in the Llanbrynmair area</u> I Edwards confirmed that all is ok at the moment except for the need for a new cabinet in Llanbrynmair. It was suggested that a training session could be organised. S Reast and I Edwards to coordinate
- 5. <u>Consider new equipment for the Playground</u> Wicksteed have finished the installation of the new play equipment and B Jones has fitted the baby swings. S Reast and B Jones to look at maintenance issues for the Zip-wire
- 6. <u>Concealed entrance, Maes yr Efail</u> B Jones and R Ashton to install metal post for mirror no update
- 7. <u>Bins at the bottom of Bryneinty Road</u> The bins were not collected along the road as they should have been according to the new arrangement. F Cauley discussed the situation with Waste Services and the confirm that it will be done correctly next time
- 8. Lloches bws Dolfach The new bus shelter has been completed
- 9. <u>Trimming hedge and undergrowth in Bont</u> Volunteers in Bont have started the work but there are uncertainties about how to tackle the higher branches. F Cauley and E Davies to meet on site to discuss options. It was remembered that the terms of the land transfer included an agreement to keep the branches clear of overhead cables

- 10. <u>Bench in Dolfach</u> The bench is in place. It was suggested that the bench waiting to go to Lland could be put on the Community field temporarily. B Jones to consider how to install securely
- 11. <u>Broken shed in the play park</u> Waiting for dry weather to move the shed no update
- 12. <u>Fence around Pump House in Bont</u> No progress. S Reast to enquire again and consider formal complaint
- 13. <u>Problems with the Health Centre</u> E Davies and S Evans gave a summary of their meeting at the Centre
- 14. <u>Dog poo</u> S Reast has done quite a lot of research into the matter and is in the process of organising a meeting with Jodie Griffith, Powys County Council Project Officer
- 15. Openreach leaving tree trimmings on the road S Reast has enquired no progress
- 16. <u>Lack of notices for Hafodwen planning application</u> A letter from Rhian Griffiths, Senior Planning Officer was presented
- 17. Path past Ysgoldy in Talerddig needs a gate It has been determined that Ysgoldy own the land. I Edwards to assess the matter
- 18. Overnight stays in the car park The signs are in place and there have been no further problems so far
- 19. Access through community field It was suggested that a small gate be installed at the entrance for people to use then the large gate can be locked. B Jones to look into the cost of materials
- 20. <u>Public footpaths</u> It was agreed that all enquiries should be referred to Richard Jones, Powys County Council
- 21. <u>Gas pipe under Brynaire road</u> Powys have agreed to co-ordinate enquiries with the gas company no progress
- 22. <u>Trees leaning over the road after Plas Pennant</u> A neighbour has trimmed the trees so the problem is resolved
- 23. <u>Problems in Glanclegyr</u> Brambles and weeds on the pavements, nettles and thistles around the small field, noise disturbance from dogs/vehicles/trailers/sheep and the request for somewhere to exercise dogs G Mitchell to meet Housing Officers on site
- 24. <u>Litter in the big field</u> The shop owner is going to encourage children to do litter picks. Keep Wales Tidy are going to drop off some equipment
- 25. Concerns about land development on the Pandy road Awaiting further details
- 26. <u>Visibility through the bus shelter in front of Wynnstay garden</u> S Reast to discuss with Traws Cambria
- 27. Golau ar hen Siop Llan S Reast has asked for an update bearing in mind that the ownership of the building has yet to be established following Bernard's death
- 28. Light opposite Pengeulan S Reast has asked again for an update
- 29. <u>Water quality</u> There is a need for progress in Welsh Water's efforts to improve the overflow of sewage into the river
- 30. <u>Local Bus Networks</u> A request from Tom Lewis, local Regional Bus Service Project Officer, was presented asking for community suggestions about developments to the service. It was felt that the current service should continue but a request was made for an additional journey to be included to get people to Machynlleth in time for work
- 31. <u>Bridle path, Esgair/Cwm Calch</u> Horse riders having difficulty getting across boggy land but it is understood that the landscape cannot be changed
